Forest Rights) Act, 2006.

Sir,

Section 3(2) of the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 provides for diversion of forest land-for the under mentioned facilities which are to be managed by the Govt. and involves feiling of trees not exceeding 75 per ha notwithstanding anything contained in the FCA, 1980.

- Anganwadis; p)
- q) Fair price shops;
- Electric and telecommunication lines; r)
- Tanks and other minor water bodies; s)

Provided that such diversion of forest land shall be allowed only if,

- The forest land to be diverted for the purposes mentioned in this sub-section ii. is less than one hectare in each case; and
- The clearance of such development projects shall be subject to the condition iii. that the same is recommended by the Gram Sabha.

- 2. Further procedure for diversion of forest land have been prescribed by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs Govt. of India vide their letter No. 23011/15-2008-SG-II dated 18.05.2009 received vide Principal Secretary (TD) to GoHP letter No. TDB(A)3-1/2007 dated 12.06.2009.
- 3. The procedure for disposal of trees where such diversion is approved by DFO of the area or District level committee as the case may be has not been indicated in any of these regulations.
- 4. As per provision of section 4 (7) of the Act, the forest right shall be conferred free of all encumbrances and procedural requirements, including clearance under the Forest (Conservation) Act,1980 requirement of paying the 'net present value (NPV) and 'compensatory afforestation' for diversion of forest land except those specified in this Act. But there is no procedure for felling of trees in the diverted forest land under FRA. The procedure of disposal of trees where road construction is involved under FCA 1980 is dealt with as per instructions contained in Pr. CCF letter No. Ft. 48-66/83(H) dated 20.02.1995 (copy enclosed as Annexure .-1) wherein trees coming in the road alignment are handed over to HP State Forest Corporation for exploitation by treating it as a lot. In all other cases than road construction, price of trees at market rates is recovered from the user agency before these are handed over to it for getting the disposal of trees. Such a procedure as per this reference had approval of the highest authority of the Govt.
- 5. In view of what indicated above, it is suggested that for easy disposal of trees in the state under section 3 (2) of Forest Rights Act, 2006, these may be handed over to HP State Forest Corporation for exploitation by treating it as a lot and cost of trees may be realized from all the Govt. agencies at market rates except HPPWD for road construction in non tribal areas.

You are requested to accord the approval for non-tribal areas in the same manner as given for tribal areas vide your office letter No. FFE-B-F-(5)-2/2002-II dated 2.2010 (copy enclosed as Annexure-II).

It has been noticed that cases under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 where diversion of forest land was involved for construction of roads by HPPWD, the price of trees at make trates has not been paid so far in many cases by the PWD on account of the fact that in the budget of that Department only construction cost of the road is provided and additionality on account of cost of trees coming in the alignment is not included. To some extent because of this snag, actual work of construction of PWD roads even where clearances have been received was getting hampened. This matter was considered at highest level of Government and it was felt that the practice of charging of market rates of trees from PVV is unnecessarily inflating the construction cost of the roads and thus hampering the developmental works.

3. After detailed discussions, it has accordingly been decided that henceforth, after clearance has been obtained for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the trees coming in road alignment schemes be handed over to the HP State Forest Corporation for working as regitar lots instead of charging market rates from PW. these instructions shall be applicable in case of HP PWD only. The PWD will pay cost on compensatory afforestation as usual. Permission for nemoval of such trees whether green or dry would not be required further once Good, of India's clearance has been neceived.
