Jai Hind,

I am directed to say that the matter with regard to grant of relief in favour of the public on account of losses caused by the Wild animals, especially by monkeys has been engaging the attention of the Government for some time past. In this context your attention is invited to Section-11(1)(a) and (b) of Chapter-III of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 which provides that Chief Wildlife Warden or the authorised officer is fully empowered to issue the permit to hunt animals which cause damage to human life or public property (including standing crops or any land).

2. You are, therefore, requested to take further necessary action to issue suitable directions to the concerned officers immediately under intimation to this Department.

ORDER NO. FT/1601-4/68(CFWL)

With the approval of the Government of Himachal Pradesh, I, the Chief Wildlife Warden, Himachal Pradesh, delegate the following powers under Section 5(2) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, to various Forest Officer and the Wildlife Wardens and the staff under them.

2. These powers will be used according to the directions received from the H.P. Govt. from time to time and under the supervision/Control of the Chief Wildlife Warden Himachal Pradesh:-
